THEATRE STUDENT PREPARATION FOR SCREENING Grades K-6

- **Part I** All students will be interviewed about their theatre interests and involvement. Should develop knowledge of how to present themselves in an interview session.
- **Part II** Students will be taken through a variety of activities dealing with movement, use of voice, creativity, characterization, imagination, pantomime, and improvisation.

Students should have a pleasant, positive attitude, be ready to participate in vocal and physical activities, be willing to take risks (nothing dangerous to health) and follow directions/instructions.

Part III (4-6 grades only) Students will be required to <u>act out one</u> <u>memorized</u> monologue from the prepared list (approximately 45-60 seconds). Costume and props are not allowed (a chair will be provided). See acceptable monologue list attached for your selection.

Monologue Preparations should include the following:

- Plan your movements and how you will use the space available
- **Memorize** your lines and your movements
- Rehearse until you know the monologue completely
- Ask others to watch you and give you some suggestions
