VISUAL ART STUDENT PREPARATION FOR SCREENING

PART I Students are required to bring their portfolio of artwork for the prescreening session at their school. Portfolio will be returned.

PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS

- 3 5 works of art which may include one to three pieces of sculpture
- Artwork must be an <u>original</u> no cartoons, tracing work, or step by step activities.
- Include a variety of techniques: may include drawing, painting, printmaking, collage, photography, illustrations.....
- Include a variety of subject matter: include works from observation (what you see) and from imagination. Examples of subject matter might include: animals, plants, people, buildings (interiors/exteriors), events or activities (sports, circus, festivals), graphic designs, original fantasy scenes, dreams, expressions of feelings.
- High School students: It is recommended you also include self-portraits, landscape compositions, interior compositions, interior and exterior perspectives, and figures in action.
- **PART II** Students will be given a drawing assignment during the prescreening. All necessary materials will be provided for the student.
